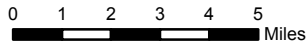

The distances do not factor in roads that are not pedestrian friendly due to factors such as high speeds, lack of either shoulders or sidewalks.

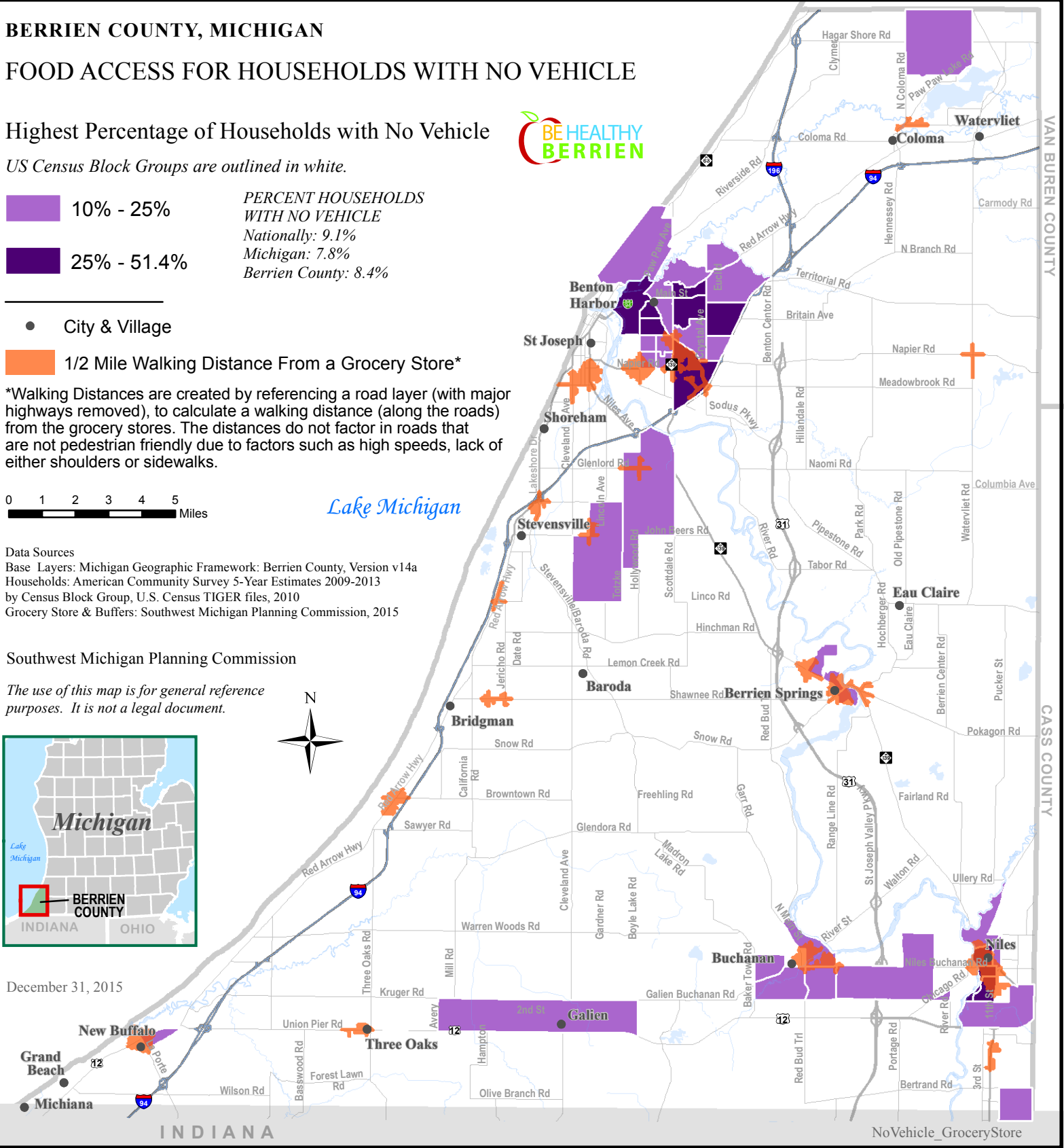
