Highest percentage of households that received Food Stamps/Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) in the past 12 months



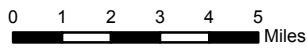

The distances do not factor in roads that are not pedestrian friendly due to factors such as high speeds, lack of either shoulders or sidewalks.
